### **Conference Logistics: Transportation**

**Lightrail:** The most cost effective option for transportation from the airport to the hotel is the RTD Lightrail. It picks-up right in the airport terminal and drops off at Union Station which is a short distance from the hotel. The cost one way is \$9. Other options include:

Uber or Lyfts are also another option and range from \$35 - \$40 one way.

Taxis are also available and they typically run for about \$55 - \$65 one way.


